Linda Lee Brewer, daughter of the late Roy Ford and Aleeta Guffey Ford, was born October 23, 1947 at West Plains, Missouri. She entered into eternal rest December 23, 2023, at the age of seventy-six years.

Linda was the youngest of three children. She graduated from West Plains High School in 1965.
